Western Australian Artist Showcase:

Positively E. 4th Street, Saturday 18th March, 2-6pm

Since 2004 WAM, the West Australian Music Industry Association, has presented a showcase of the best acts from the furthest point on the globe to Austin Texas. That's right, bands from Perth Western Australia travel further than any others to attend SxSW. Yet, the quality of the lineup this year is, as previously, undeniable.

In the words of Philip Stevens, the man behind The John Butler Trio, The Waifs, Little Birdy and now The Flairz, "The showcase organised by WAM is the highlight of the weekend."

In 2006 WAM presents End Of Fashion, Gyroscope and The Flairz. You can read about the bands elsewhere in this magazine but the reality is that if you want to see a show that truly rocks, Positively E. 4th Street is the place to be on Saturday afternoon, 18 March from 3pm.

Positively E. 4th Street is a new venue in town, an old Texaco warehouse described as "seriously funky and hopelessly hip". Later in the evening the place will be handed over to the NYC label Kemado who will no doubt be seeing the morn-

ing light in with their own party action. This venue will be a step up from WAM's previous outings, especially with Austin's own Damon Lange providing a front of house experience that is the best Austin can dish up.

So what is it that makes bands from Western Australia so damn good? Some suggest that it must be something in the water. That's geographically impossible. Perth is one of the driest cities of its size (1.5 million) in the world - we don't have any water! More likely is the barrier that local bands face in getting out of Perth, which means that by the time they leave our part of the world they are already gig hardened with plenty of experience under their belts. Further to that, isolation requires that local artists tend to be very outward looking, and more aware therefore of what's going on elsewhere. And finally, the isolation breeds a camaraderie amongst the bands, the managers, the labels and the media that contributes to an incredibly strong local scene.

And with a peak music body (WAM) that is envied around not only Australia but the world for its vision and passion for promoting local music, there's a common sense of purpose that drives our bands to be the best that there is. Perth is frequently referred to as the new Liverpool/ Seattle/ Manchester (take your pick).

WAM works relentlessly at developing the local industry. From the annual WAMi Festival, which attracts massive attention nation wide for the 120 or so acts that fill a week of hot Perth summer nights each February, to our annual songwriting competition (over 1500 entries), to our youth audience development programs (over 120 under-age gigs presented each year), to our annual Kiss My WAMi compilation and through many, many more activities WAM achieves this aim for the 900 or more bands that we have listed in our database.

So, what will you experience on Saturday afternoon at Positively E. 4th Street? The Flairz will deliver what the kids today want - AC/DC styled

four on the floor rock'n'roll (Perth is the final resting place of Bon Scott, whose family still live there). Gyroscope will jump up and down and shove their power punk rock down your throat till you wish you could scream for more. And End Of Fashion (who along with Gyroscope have seen a degree of chart success in Australia) quite simply blows away every crowd that dares to stand in front of them. They were a highlight of SxSW 2004 and return this year with only one thing to prove - how good they are.

Goddamn, you'll be picked up, spun around, set down, and left wondering what on earth YOU can do to make things better than they already are.

Believe me, things are going to be pretty darn good at Positively E. 4th St on Saturday the 18th.
